

## So...you're thinking about having a tent event?

We are often asked "How much are your tents?" This is a very difficult question to answer since we offer three different styles of tents and over 40 size options. There are many factors involved in choosing the right size tent for your special-event and it is not an easy recommendation for us to make quickly. Below is a list of questions for your consideration. Accurate answers to these questions will help guide us in recommending the proper size tent for your location and type of event.


1. What would your maximum guest count be?
2. Will your guests be seated at round or rectangular tables?
3. Will you have bar service? Hors d'oeuvre service?
4. What type of food-service will you have? Buffet or Sit-Down
5. Will you need a Dance Floor?
6. What type of entertainment are you having? Band, DJ, Other
7. What does the entertainment need? Stage, Table, Electric, Other
8. Will you need a gift table? Will you need a cake table?
9. Will you be using a head table? If so, how many should it seat?
10. Can ground stakes be used at the proposed tent location?
11. Are there any underground utilities or permanent obstructions at the site?
12. What time does your event begin? What time does it end?
13. Will you require lighting under or around the tent? (Ex: parking area)
14. Is electricity available on-site or will you need to use a generator?
15. Will you need additional restroom facilities or hand-washing equipment?
16. Will you need a public address system?
17. Is there anything else going on underneath the tent? (Ex: ceremony, etc.)
18. Are there any other special considerations? (Ex: wheelchair accessibility)

In addition to answering the above questions, your event location may determine what type and size of tent to use. Pole tents are cheaper, per square foot, than Frame tents. Pole tents require ground staking and have center poles. Frame tents are self-supportive, do not require center poles and can be used on hard surfaces where staking is not an option. However, frame tents still need to be weighted. Canopies are small pole tents and can be an inexpensive do-it-yourself option.

Additional accessories can be rented to enhance any tent event. We offer both solid and window sidewalls. In addition, decorative treatments like pole coverings, planter boxes, chandeliers, paper lanterns, or hanging baskets of ferns or florals, can be discussed with our full-time decorator and designer. 
